We seek local families in need, and through an application process held within the community, families are selected by our Volunteer Family Selection Committee. All HFH homeowners participate in the building of their own home. Once a build is complete, the homeowner makes monthly mortgage payments (0% interest) to LC Habitat. These payments are used in part to build homes for other selected families in the future!

Accepts: furniture, large appliances, cabinet sets, building materials, tools, hardware, housewares and more!

For 34 years, CHC has been helping people in difficult circumstances by providing food, clothing, and other basic needs while also cultivating hope through sincere caring and ongoing support.

Accepts: unopened/packaged food that has not expired; unopened toiletries; cleaning supplies; paper products; diapers; baby formula; clean gently-used clothing; shoes; dishes, silverware, pots, and pans; clean, good condition bedding; small microwaves, coffee makers, crockpots, etc.

Does not accept: furniture; mattresses; baby cribs; used car seats; old, tube TV sets, or home décor items

Restore Décor responds to needs in our community on an on-going basis. Each week, we find out about families that can use a hand up. Sometimes, they need furniture and we are able to donate beds, dressers, and other needed items quickly in crisis situations. Several times throughout the year, we pick a different local family or organization directly serving people in need. We advertise that 100% of Saturday's net sales will go directly to that family/group.

Accepts: mostly wooden furniture that can be painted. Our volunteers can update chair-cushion upholstery & make minor repairs. We accept some home décor items in good/current condition

Does not accept: fully upholstered items (e.g. couches, recliners) unless they are of a contemporary style and in near-perfect condition. We do not accept computer armoires or entertainment centers, particle board, water-damaged, items in poor conditions or baby cribs.

Goodwill continued...

Accepts: most household items including, but not limited to, clothing, linens, shoes, accessories, home goods, kitchen wares, etc,

Does not accept:

Large furniture over 40"

Tube (CRT) style televisions and computer monitors

Household chemical products: pesticides, paint, paint thinner, drain cleaner, oven cleaner, aerosols and other environmentally-unfriendly waste products

Automotive hazardous waste: tires, lead acid batteries, additives, gasoline, oils, antifreeze, etc.

Car parts or tires

Air conditioners, furnaces, trash compactors, water heaters, large console stereos, freon-based appliances, etc.

Partially used or open personal care items such as: nail polish remover, perfume, shampoo, shaving cream, hairsprays, etc.

Food

Mattresses/box springs, including water bed mattresses and water bed frames

Fuel powered tools

Building materials: sinks, toilets, plumbing fixtures, carpeting/padding

Single-stream recyclables such as glass, newspapers, office paper, cardboard, plastics, magazines, junk mail, etc.
